REPAIRS, &c.

The Bottom outside, cleaned and painted with two coats of paint and one coat of tallow; Inside, all the ceiling on the flat of bottom removed fore and aft. the cement patched and thickened, when required, the floor plates and reversed frames coated with thin cement fore peak cleaned out, iron work examined found in good condition; a quantity of ceiling now removed; Windlass stripped and unhung, and chains ranged on deck for examination found good and complete.
