REPAIRS, &c. Now done through damage, Two plates of topside, two plates in stroke below & two plates in bridge side renewed, Port side. One plate of topside rotten out reset & replaced, Two broken frames & one bent do. in coal bunker strengthened with corresponding angles fitted at back passing over butts. Two broken frames in fore hold new upper parts fitted, strengthened with corresponding angles at back past over butts, Also one bent do. Two broken reverse bars new at upper parts. bridge waterways better up repaired & replaced. Side Windcap repaired, moulding rails repaired, Bridge deck caulked, keel coated with paint.
