Lumber boards and ceiling equal to three Strakes removed in the Fore, and after Hold, the asphalt found sound, and adhering satisfactorily to the Iron. —
 The ceiling in the Main Hold was not lifted on account of Cargo, the Owners promising to do this at the first opportunity. —
 Inside ironwork scraped, and painted, Bottom cleaned, and coated with Red lead, Deck caulked, Chains ranged, Capstan examined, and Boilers repaired. —
 She is now eligible to be raised to A Class if the Committee should approve thereof.
