Fifty-four keel rivets and thirty-two thro' main-frames in way of fore-foot renewed. Upper and lower edges of garboard, on each side from lower part of stem to about sixteen feet abaft same, together with butts of garboard for same distance as also some few butts on each side in flat of bottom and around the bilges caulked. The plate on starb^d bilge taken down set fair and replaced.

Bottom cleaned and coated with patent composition and Gallon.
