REPAIRS, &c.

The bottom cleaned and coated with Tar from the keel to light line, from thence upwards with Buchanan's Composition, inside scraped and painted all fore and aft with two coats of white zinc, all the ceiling removed, and the greater portion of it renewed, cement examined, patched where required and thickened at the middle line all fore & aft. Rudder pintles bushed, fitted new fore-top-sail-yard, fore-top-gallant mast, and royal yard of R. Pin
