 in wake of the foregoing. five lengths of deck planks. a length
 of fore covering board, teak rough tree rail, and skirting board.
 Supplied her with two new boats in lieu of those lost.
 Six beam ends made good. - the dunnage battens, and all
 work occasioned by the collision.
