The whole of the ceiling in the hold lifted and all cement taken out, all oxidation cut or beaten off, the hold cleaned and properly prepared for survey. Plating drilled in many places and no perceptible diminution found from the original thickness - Windlass untung and stripped and chains ranged - Decks new last survey and plank sheers then surveyed for survey -

120 fathoms of 1 3/8 inch new Chain has now been supplied tested at Lloyd's Proving house to 34 tons the Certificate signed L. R. Stitt
