Cleaned the Hold, lifted nearly the whole of the Ceiling planks. the timbers fore and aft. Recemented her where required. Renewed a large portion of the Ceiling planks. Lifted and repaired the Rudder, also the steering gear. Recoated her outside, and put all in order.
