The whole of ceiling lifted in consequence of defects surface of iron found good where exposed, cement in places repaired Ceiling renewed fore & aft with 2 1/2 in Pitch Pine Bottom outside coated with paint Wld Lead It is submitted that this defect being due for S.S. No. 2 in 1874, removal of the Ceiling to full extent required by Rule may be dispensed with at that period
