Lifted the Limbers, and three Strakes of Ceiling planks fore and aft each side. the Cement on the Port side found good and adhering satisfactorily, on the Starb^d side found some small portions of the Asphalt deficient in places, - examined and repaired it, relaid and caulked the Ceilings. Cleand^d her out inside, examined ribs, rivets and plating. Cleand^d the bottom and recoated it. Unhung the Windlasp gave her a new main piece, with spindle passing through. Examined the pumps. - Lifted the chain Cables from the lockers, ranged them along the deck, they proved sufficient in size, and in quantity also. -
