REPAIRS, &c.

Now done in consequence of Damage.
 The following renewed, on the luff of the Starboard bow, one sheerstrake plate, one of topsides adjoining, and one plate of forecastle drifts, one plate of main struiger plate and one of forecastle, and nine planks of main deck and four of forecastle deck, of yellow pine - the border planks of Deck - two frames and one reversed frame cut and scarphed. and the vessel made as efficient as she was before the accident.
