Line Paint, & the Sun's Pat Comp.; Rudder unhung & bushed,  
briding in hold / Stitches / equal to 3 Strakes, and Linerboards,  
fore and aft, on each side removed for examination of Cement,  
which was found in good condition. Windlass (Sun Patent)  
repaired. Chain cables refit and together with the general  
equipment examined as prescribed - and all other requirements  
of the Rule complied with -
