The Bottom cleaned down and coated with paint, and enamel; the timber boards and ceiling equal to one strake fore and aft on each side removed; the cement examined found sound and good, and adhering satisfactorily to the Iron. Three strakes of ceiling on Starboard side renewed, and Iron work exposed scraped and painted. New lower main top rail fitted.
