Vessel placed in Dry Dock to right Bottom having struck a Rock, and broken three blades of the Screw: three started Rivets renewed; two Butts recaulked, and the lower edge of Garboard plate on Starboard side aft. dressed and chipped. Bottom scraped and repainted with two coats of Paint.
