Ceiling equal to three strakes and the lumber boards on each side extending from Main Mast right forward taken up - found the plates and rivets in good condition but the Cement in a few places wasted and has been repaired; hull scraped & painted where required; the Windlass (Harfield's) refitted and the Cables ranged out - examined, and found complete.
