Placed on blocks in dry dock; the timber and ceiling equal to several years on each side fore and aft removed, with both surfaces of outside plating exposed. The Cement carefully inspected, and found sound and good. The bottom cleaned and coated with three coats of Zinc paint, and one of tallow; inside Iron work scraped clean and painted.
