All the hatches in Ceiling lifted. and Ceiling making at least 6 Strakes all fore & aft. on each side of the keelson, lifted for an examination of the frames, floors, plating, Cement &c. and found in good condition; Scraped and Chipped from bilges upwards on the inside and painted. Windlass in hung and wad. lining stripped, examined and found in good condition. Chains ranged on deck and found complete.**
