## REPAIRS, &c.

The timber-boards, and ceiling equal to three strakes all fore and aft, on each side removed; the frames plating, rivets &c in way of same found to be in a satisfactory state, the cement-coating sound and good except in a few places which have now been repaired, and adhering firmly to the iron. Chain-cables ranged on deck for examination.

Rudder pintles repaired. The bottom cleaned and coated with Paint and Sallow, and the topsides with Paint.
