REPAIRS, &c.

Lifted the timbers. and ceiling hatches, equivalent to a strake or more than a strake, excepting two portions of the lower hold the Cement generally proved in excellent condition: of good quality and adhering satisfactorily, or as far as seen. Cleaned her out inside and repainted her with red lead, Treasured her outside with Mc'Guinnep's composition. and completed the Survey inside excepting for a length of about 40 ft. i.e. 20 ft abast the foremast in the flat of her. and 20 ft. fore side of the after hatch also in the flat and, next the Keelson. - a new iron cap fitted to the Main Mast and made good the rigging. -
