REPAIRS, &c.

The owners have now substituted at their own option, two Power Anchors weighing 36" 3" 6" & 36" 3" 5", instead of two weighing 35" 1" 23" & 28" 3" 23" respectively; and they have also substituted 300 fathoms of 1" 15/16 Chain Cable for 300 fms of 1" 14/16.

The Anchors & Cables now supplied were tested by Mr M. K. Reade at Retherton on the 31<sup>st</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup> 1873.

The equipment is now complete and in good and efficient order.
