The bottom cleaned and painted, the limber boards and ceiling equal to three strakes fore and aft on each side removed the cement and iron work examined found in good condition Chains ranged on deck Windlass Iron Patent. Boiler repaired, a new propeller fitted, and the two lower rudder braces renewed.
