new propeller fitted, all the lids in water ballast tanks taken off for an examination of Cement &c, also the hold cleared in other respects and the ships of Ceiling lifted as required by Rule for an examination of floors, frames, plates &c, and where thus exposed found in good Condition. Above the bulges on the inside now scraped and painted, some few pieces of angle iron to hold beams and in way of hatchways repaired and made good, deck Caulked, 3 side ports on each side in the Tween-decks fitted with hinges to swing, also two extra scuppers
