REPAIRS, &c. On account of damage sustained through striking the ground: stem taken out lower part repaired, and repiveted. Two fore plates of garboard strake renewed, also several rivets in the two adjoining strakes each side from collision bulkhead forward. One breasthook refitted. Cement renewed in line of the new work. A few frame rivets amidships on the port side renewed. Rudder stops renewed. Bottom scraped and coated.
