REPAIRS, &c. now done. Bottom scraped and painted

All the hatches in Ceiling lifted, also in the end of vessel, making about six strikes all fore & aft on both sides of the keelson for an examination of the floors, frames, plating. Cement, &c., all of which found in good condition. Small repairs to the Cement where found necessary. Windlass unhung and wood-lining stripped and found in good order. Chain cables ranged on deck and found complete.
