REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

On account of damage through running over her anchor and grounding while on her late voyage from Riga to the Thames: - One plate in the flat of bottom on the Star^d side taken off faired and re-riveted, a few rivets in butt straps renewed, and a few butts in flat caulked. Bottom scraped and recoated. Cat-Davit renewed.
