REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

The Vessel docked on blocks. the ceiling in flat lifted all fore and aft, fore and after peeks scraped and beaten clean and painted, the cement where defective made good, the bottom cleaned and coated with Paint and Tallow and the topsides with Paint. the cement renewed all fore and aft about two feet above the close ceiling
