Work done: Lighted the bottom and scraped and painted the bottom with three coats of paint. Lifted a good deal of the filing in the flats and thoroughly cleaned the timbers out. The cement was adhering firmly to the iron. - New Fore and Main Topmasts and Lib. boom and Mizzen Mast of Oregon.
