*Now done - All the Ceiling from the main keelson to upper belge stringer both sides fore & aft - renewed of P Pine & spruce fir.
 A large number of the rivets in flat of bottom - both sides - renewed thro' oxidation, windlass unhooked & linings removed, Carler ranged out, examined & found complete, and the hull scraped and painted where required.
 Cap heads renewed of G heart, Rudder repaired, and Cement in flat of bottom renewed.*
