REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE. Now done thro stress of weather, & grounding.

The topside strake doubled with 12th plates for a length of 210 feet in midship body, and all the side ports in way of same closed up. Twenty butt straps in upper deck sheerstrake and six in main deck &c. on each side midship body riveted, some of the rivets renewed in stringer angle irons, and the bottom scraped & painted.

A large number of keel rivets renewed irrespective of damage.
