The stone ballast-taken out from between the floors - extending from fore part of main hatch to near foremast - found the floors, rivets, & cement in way of same in good condition - was informed by the Captain that this was the only portion of the bottom not seen by Mr. Boolds.

The Cables ranged out; examined & found complete. Windlass renewed in London Oct-71 - Bill for same produced.
