REPAIRS, or EXAMINATION AS PER RULE for Special Survey No. 2.

Now done. - Vessel placed in Dry Dock; Bottom scraped clean, and found in good condition, and re-painted and coated with composition; a great number of planks in ceiling lifted in the fore and after parts of the Main Hold. This Vessel is filled up solid between the floors to the upper part, with Stones and Cement; (intended for Ballast) several spaces have been now cleared, and re-cemented without an opportunity being afforded me of examining the plates, frames &c. in way thereof, contrary to my instructions to the Master, and Chief Officer on board the Ship.

The Vessel is now ordered hurriedly to Liverpool, where, by the Master's information, the survey is to be completed.
