REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE The recommendations of the Chief Surveyor  
respecting the main deck stringer angle irons of this vessel have  
been carried out, the ribs having been carefully examined,  
the faulty ones removed & renewed & the remainder caulked together  
with the seams & butts of the angle irons, the wood moulding has  
also been removed with the exception of a small portion round  
the stern where it was not considered necessary the ribs being  
much better laid up there, the bolt-holes through the side and  
through the angle irons for fastening the same are now rivitted  
up.
