Not done. Nearly all the ceiling in flat of bottom and part at the bidge both sides fore & aft taken up, all oxidation removed - found the plates, rivets, & Cement in good condition; took plates riveted and two others added to prevent painting; windlass (Harfield's) in good order, and the cables ranged out, examined and found complete.

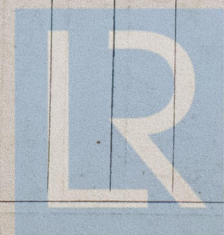
