REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Three Decks

Seven scuttles for ventilation have now been cut in the SheersmaRe abreast of main Rigging and after Hatchway. The scuttles 8th dia^m, and the cutting of SheersmaRe compensated for, by introducing a Clamp plate ^{there} 16x8 and pinnetted to each frame. The plate extending to the frame before and the frame abaft the end scuttles.
