How done, Broken Stem taken out & replaced with new, four plates & forecaste, two garboard plates, ten shell plates & one of sheerstrake taken off & replaced with new, 9 broken frames cut on the P. Side proper shifts made & new parts fitted, also 7 reverse frames, two broken frames cut on the S. Side & new parts fitted, two broken shell plates taken off hull & Port bow & two at bulge midships, the same replaced with new, one broken tank side plate with angle iron at lower edge, replaced with new, one plate on top of ballast tank, new broken floor plate at end midships repaired with new plate, four broken bulge & hold stringer angles replaced with new, Batted blocks on Monkey forecaste refitted, short length of waterway new P. Side, Hawse pipes refitted, Forepart of Deck resurfaced, Canvas relaid with top of water ballast tanks, bedding relaid in fore hold, keel abraded down & coated with paint & black varnish.
