Through striking of the River

Plating cut out at stems from lower part of stem upwards, stems removed set fair & replaced. Fore lengths of plating each side of stem set fair and set broken plates renewed. Fore frame cut out set fair & replaced. Breasthooks when removed replaced.

Renewed deck planks on each side of main hatchway forward from front of bridge with pitch pine & caulked. Bottom cleaned & painted.
