Now done, three bow plates renewed on the starboard side, and a short piece of one from close forward, also a few rivets where found starting adjacent to the new plates cut out and renewed. One bulwark plate taken off on the starboard side amidships set fair and again refitted. Two frames forming the roughster stanchions heated and set straight - Capstan repaired. One piece of roughster rail in way of damaged bulwark now renewed. Deck side house repaired and one new boat.
