**Now done**, One length of frame angle iron; 6 bottom plates, & 2 plates of the Bulwark, one plate of upper deck stringer and one length of stringer angle iron in wake of dr. renewed; one Sheerstrake plate and 1 plate of the topsides made fair; Lie plates upon upper deck made good and 7 planks of deck renewed with yellow pine and the deck caulked in way of new work. The bottom coated with 2 coats of paint.

I have been unable to correct the information required in the register book owing to the Captain not producing the Ship's register as promised.
