## REPAIRS, &c.

S. 3. No. 1. 74 11.34

Having being ashore on the coast in the Red Sea  
She has been put in Dry Dock, bottom scraped, and examined.  
Found several bad rivets in the Garboard Strake thro'  
the keel near the stem.

Driven out and refitted, Garboard Seams & butts  
caulked

Under the bottom on the port side aft of the collision bulhead, outside  
found the plates slightly bent, for about 5 spaces of frame in  
length, and four rivets started.

Refitted the rivets, the seams and butts properly caulked.  
Inside at the corresponding place found 6 frames broken, but only  
one flange of the said frame; made good by the application of angle  
iron about 5 feet long, and properly refitted to the frame.
