REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

After damage: Line plates on the Star Board and two of the Forecastle plates renewed. 3 frames port new. The deck patch renewed forward on Star side, and other repairs to Beams, and Forecastle. The Bridge deck extended aft at the sides for the better protection of the space enclosing Engine & Boilers. The Bridge deck being now about 39 feet in length and firmly secured.

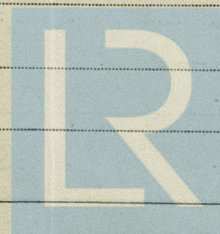
