Vessel placed on blocks in dry dock, hold cleared stages made, all the close ceiling removed, cement examined and found good and adhering satisfactorily to the iron, floors, frames and plating sealed and painted, holes drilled in various parts of plating in comparison with the first entry report little or no diminution in thickness found - She has been fitted with a new rudder and new steering wheel, also main topgallant mast renewed - decks found sufficient in thickness, and several shifts renewed; bottom outside coated with paint and tallow.
