Particulars of Repairs and Examination New engines, New Main boiler and mountings fitted. The propeller and propeller shaft renewed. The intermediate shafting in the tunnel overhauled. New Sea-Cocks and valves fitted. The donkey boiler repaired and tested in Messrs J. Richardson & Sons works. to 90 lbs per sq. inch. Steam was raised in the main boiler and the engines worked May 27th/76. and all worked very satisfactory. Steam 65 lbs. Vacuum 28 inches, revolutions 68.
In my opinion the engines and boilers of this vessel are in good order and safe working condition.
