*New Doubl-Plank bow plates on each side renewed, three broken main frames and ten reversed frames repaired by doubling pieces, a stiffening bar fitted to collision bulkhead, three painting beams repaired & refitted, about 40 bolts recaulked and one hundred rivets renewed, two shifts of deck renewed bottom scraped and painted, ceiling repaired, cement renewed where necessary, fore water ballast tank tested, deck caulked, hold cleared*
