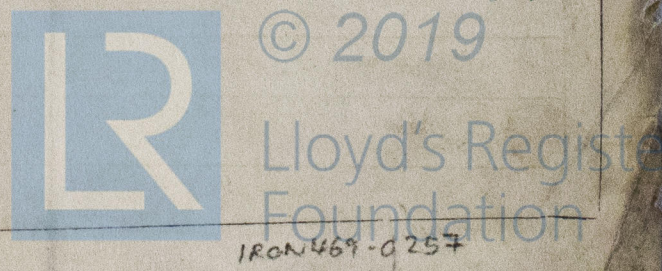
The whole of the close ceiling removed, frames &c chipped and scraped and coated with cement wash. ceiling replaced and renewed where necessary. Cement repaired generally.
