The ship was docked in the evening of the 23rd Feb  
 was placed on high blocks & examined in the morning  
 of the 24th found the bottom in first rate order, the rudder  
 & propellers <sup>beginning repainting</sup> in good order. This has been done with potash white paint  
 The ship thoroughly painted & coated with antiseptic composition  
 I also examined the hold, tanks & the two ends of the  
 ship found everything clear, in good order, & in a good state  
 of preservation
