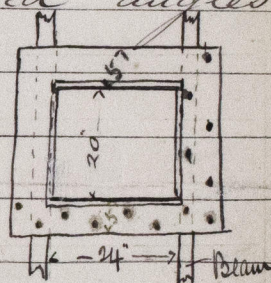

REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE Annual Survey &c.

The vessel placed upon blocks in Dry Dock; and the bottom cleaned & coated with Red Lead.

Eight holes each (24" x 20") have been cut in the plating of the Middle Deck on each side, in the strake of the deck plating next to the stringer plate.

These holes which are intended to assist in the stowage of the cargo, are placed in the fore and after holds respectively; and as compensation for the cutting of the deck plates, forged angles 3" x 3" x 7/8" are riveted to the deck plating as per sketch.
