## REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE

Temporary repairs caused by collision.  
New stem and apron of Rock Maple Port  
bow where damaged replaced with Tamarac  
timbers, splanked with 4 1/2" x 5" Rock Elm  
over feet & secured with seven bolts & three  
treenails. Waterways & clamps worked  
around both bows & well secured. In the  
after hold several frames are broken & they  
are now clamped with straps.
