REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE for S.S. No 2

Vessel placed in dry dock and bottom scraped and painted. The timbers and ceiling equivalent to three strakes on both sides lifted right fore and aft. The cement found everywhere in good condition and closely adhesion to the iron. Where worn on the surface it has now been repaired. Six ceiling hatches renewed with P. Pine. Fore peak cleared, oxidation removed from the surface of the iron and painted. The windlass stripped and unbung and chain cables ran for examination.
