REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE SS No 1.

The bottom of this vessel was examined in dry in July this year, the timbers and two strakes of ceiling have now been taken up on both sides, without the double bottom, likewise all the ceiling and Man hole doors removed from the double bottom and found good, the cement tested which was adhering firmly to the iron & Mendax and thickened where worn. The double bottom tested to the light water line.
