## Particulars of Repairs and Examination

Cylinder covers, pump covers, Condenser doors &c removed. The engines throughout examined and overhauled, Shafting relined, Steam Tube bushes repaired. The Boiler doors removed the boiler scaled & cleaned, and put in good order. A clamp fitted over crosshead in way of slight flaw.

The machinery and Boiler of this vessel are now in a good and efficient condition and in my opinion entitle the vessel to retain the Lloyd's M.C. (in red) and to be marked from this date.
